Stephanie Alison Walker's *LOVE IN THE TIME OF FORECLOSURE* is a first-person account from someone who's made it to the other side. It's a frontline story of the entire foreclosure process, including the costs no one talks about—the gut-wrenched anxieties and a stress-tested marriage along with endless support from family and friends.

She's sharing her story so others know what to expect—from lenders, from brokers, from the family across the street. Walker hopes to remove the stigma of foreclosure.

“The biggest triumph for me,” she writes, “is really getting that we don't need money and stuff to make us happy. We just need each other and a good dose of perspective.”

Walker believes she's better off because of it. And her positive attitude, even as she loses everything, is a lesson for everyone in times like these.

The story follows Walker and her husband from their first foreclosure notice to the day they move out, complete with Kafka-esque lenders, last-ditch phone calls to the governor, realtors from hell and awkward looks across the office.

The book is adapted from Walker's popular blog—with new stories and new insights she was unable to share and make public at the time.
